It's brought me great joy to see Eastwood neighbors gathering again at community events and at ENA's annual meeting last month. Due to pandemic restrictions, ENA's programming over the past few years has been limited. At ENA's annual meeting, the board of directors reports to the members on recent activities, financial status of the organization and the members elect the 17-member board of directors. At the annual meeting, we welcomed six new board members and one returning board member. You can review the annual report at eastwoodneighbor.com/news. With many new board members and three new officers, we are energized and excited to expand upon ENA's programs and events. I am honored to have recently been elected president of the board by this great group of talented Eastwood boosters.

Recently, the Eastwood Neighborhood Association, along with its members:

- Installed decorative fencing around the Eastwood Community Garden with a state grant secured by Assemblyman Bill Magnarelli
- Completed construction of Mazella Memorial Basketball Court at Eastwood Heights Park, supported by over \$30,000 in donations from the Eastwood community
- Hosted the 16th Annual Eastwood 5-Mile Run bringing over 200 runners from all over CNY to Eastwood
- Hosted a six-week series of early morning yoga classes in the Community Garden, free and open to the public
- Hired a local artist to paint a little free library donated by County Legislator Peggy Chase and installed it at the Eastwood Community Garden
- Established annual scholarships named after Eastwood greats Tom White, Margaret McVicker, and Aaron Wood
- Hosted the second annual Beastwood Skate Competition at East Woods Skate Plaza
- Secured a \$200,000 state grant with assistance from Senator Rachel May for the expansion of the East Woods Skate Plaza
- Raised nearly \$7,000 for the installation of new raised beds in Greenway Park
- Completed extensive updates to our website: eastwoodneighbor.com
- Began mass email communications to keep our members better informed about ENA activities
- Hosted ENA's annual meeting last month featuring guest speaker, Mayor Ben Walsh

None of this could have been accomplished without you, our members, our donors, and volunteers. You are what makes this organization, and our neighborhood, great. Thank you for being such an important part of Eastwood's continued growth and vitality.
