WHAT:

Eastwood American Legion Post 1276 and the Eastwood Neighborhood Association are jointly hosting the 2023 Eastwood Memorial Day Parade. The more than 70-year-old annual parade honoring military members who died in service, which had not been held in three years due to the pandemic, will begin at 9am on Monday, May 29, from the Legion on the corner of James Street and Nichols Avenue in Eastwood. The parade will end at the Greenway War Memorial at the roundabout at James Street and Grant Boulevard in front of Walgreen's. A short ceremony honoring local military members will feature raising of the flag, an invocation, and the National Anthem played by the Henninger High School Band. The ceremony will include presentation of wreaths and comments from elected officials and Legion and military representatives.
